I provide independent medico-legal opinions in **personal injury and clinical negligence cases** involving hand injuries, nerve damage, scarring, and plastic surgery. I am the director of the hand and peripheral nerve fellowship programme and on the board of education for the Global Nerve Foundation. I have recently been awarded the PLASTA Trainer of the year in the UK and Ireland and been featured on Channel 5's "Surgeons: A matter of life and death" performing nerve surgery in Season 3 on two episodes (1 and 6). My reports are **CPR Part 35 compliant**, and my duty is to the **Court**. I accept instructions from **Claimants, Defendants and as a Joint Expert**.

### Current Clinical Practice

I work within a Level 3 Major Trauma Centre managing complex trauma including upper limb fractures, tendon, nerve soft tissue injuries and reconstruction and polytrauma cases. I regularly perform joint procedures with orthopaedics, vascular, neurosurgery, ENT, Spinal and General surgery. I manage **iatrogenic injuries on a weekly basis** which is directly relevant to medicolegal work. I have published 41 papers and written 3 books.
